<u>Changes to Communion. The Church of England</u> systems have changed: to allow children of any age to receive bread and non-alcoholic wine at Communion before they are Confirmed, provided the child has been baptised and has received suitable preparation in church. Confirmation then remains an important occasion at an older age when young people make their adult declarations of faith.
