
Wednesday 10.30am Holy Communion services paused. It will Recommence 14th September.

<u>Covid Update</u>: We have two areas of church seating: In the back 3 open pews on the right as you enter (main road side), alternate pews only will be used and masks worn at all times. The Church of England</u> systems have changed: to allow children of any age to receive bread and non-alcoholic wine at Communion before they are Confirmed, provided the child has been baptised and has received suitable preparation in church. Confirmation then remains an important occasion at an older age when young people make their adult declarations of faith.
